## Who Should Attend?

The target group for this course includes:

- People already working in a context where they come into contact with women and children subjected to domestic and family violence
- Workers who want to develop their skills and knowledge in the areas of domestic and family violence

## What does the course cover?

**Module One:** Identifies and responds to domestic and family violence (DFV) during professional contact with clients. Participants will gain knowledge and understanding of DFV, awareness of its effects, the ability to respond confidently and appropriately and provide relevant and timely information and referral.

**Module Two:** Covers skills and knowledge required to identify risk indicators, develop safety plans, follow appropriate referral processes and provide networking and interagency coordination to respond to DFV.

**Module Three:** Identifies skills and knowledge required to recognise and respond to family violence, the impact of values and attitudes upon work practice, indicators of stress and vicarious trauma and self-care support strategies when working with clients experiencing DFV.
